### Investment Forum for Sustainable Metropolises

### "A unique event to connect the demand and the supply sides of urban financing market"

The first **Urban Investment Forum for Sustainable Metropolises** (UIF) is organized by FMDV and Metropolis and will take place in Brussels on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June during the 14<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Metropolis. It will mobilize relevant practitioners, metropolitan political representatives and their teams, development finance institutions, UN agencies, public and private investors and service providers around the topics of financing and investing in metropolitan projects.

The Forum wis held under the umbrella of the Malaga Global Coalition for Financial Ecosystem that works for Cities and Local Governments, co-initiated by UNCDF, UCLG and FMDV. The Malaga Global Coalition gathers major global institutions involved in local finance, as well as central and local governments, to exchange and promote global policy goals to unlock finance for cities.

### The Urban Investment Forum for Sustainable Metropolises

### The UIF aims to:

- Organize a space for multistakeholder dialogues involving representatives from metropolitan governments and potential financial partners;
- Stimulate peer-to-peer exchanges amongst metropolises on urban investment issues & solutions;
- Connect projects led by Cities with adequate funding and financing opportunities, from project preparation facilities to donors, investors and guarantees instruments.

### The UIF is organized around two pillars:

- A solution track: Experience-sharing session to exchange and spotlight inspiring funding and financing practices developed by public and private actors, including representatives of metropolitan authorities, local governments networks, donors, investors and/or private companies.
- An action track: Matchmaking session to connect urban investment opportunities with potential public or private financiers, from a curated selection of short-listed projects. During this matchmaking session, project holders will pitch their project before a group of financial institutions and investors specially invited for the occasion, for reaction and comments.

### **Important dates:**

- 28<sup>th</sup> of February 2023: Launch of the call for proposals
- 19<sup>th</sup> of April 2023: Closure of the call for proposals
- 15<sup>th</sup> of May 2023: Announcement of the selected projects
- 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2023: Urban Investment Forum, on the closing day of the 14<sup>th</sup> Metropolis World Congress<sup>1</sup>

### **Details on the Call for Proposals**

### WHO?

- Metropolitan areas with more than 1 million inhabitants;
- Metropolis members or cities committing to become a member.

### WHAT?

- All projects falling under metropolitan competencies (services or infrastructures);
- Projects seeking external resources that are not about grant funding.

### HOW?

By answering the application form before April 19<sup>th</sup> 2023;

### WHY?

- Unique chance to pitch your project to a group of potential technical and financial partners during the Metropolis World Congress in Brussels, in the context of a dedicated and exclusive
- Promotion of the selected projects by Metropolis, FMDV and UCLG through their communication channels so as to attract attention and promote the cities' leadership;
- Follow-up, after the congress, by Metropolis, FMDV and UCLG teams.

The analysis and selection of the projects will be done by a jury composed of FMDV, Metropolis and UCLG staff, and the selection will be announced on the 15th of May 2023.
