- Volume of traffic

- Encroachment of some commercial establishments along the proposed road expansion
- Erected electrical posts and other utilities along road-right-of way
- Inefficient road project implementation

KEY STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS OF THE PROJECT

- Road Widening (additional 2 lanes both sides)
- Opening of alternate routes (circumferential and diversion roads)
- Provide resettlement sites to affected illegal settlers
- ➤ Involve all stakeholders in the planning & implementation stage (DPWH, COTELCO, MKWD & affected businessmen & households)
- Installation of Traffic Lights
- Construction of Overpass
