- 834 km bus network (incl. BRT lines)

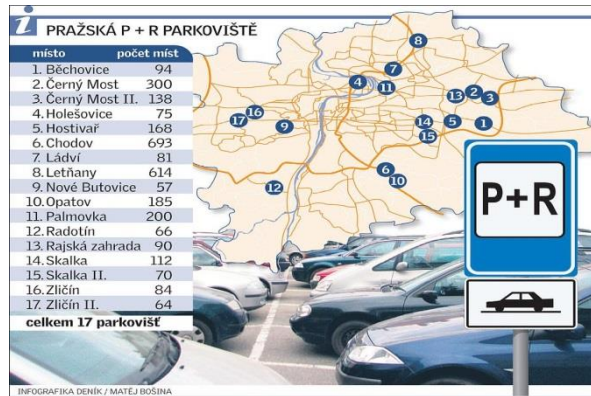
- About 1,2 bill. passengers in PT/year
