◆ Saemangeum

The world's longest seawall was built in Saemangeum, ultimately changing the geographical features of Korea and Northeast Asia. This eco-friendly place strikes harmony between human and nature. The implementation of the Korea-China Economic Cooperation Complex and establishment of a special economic cooperation zone are driving Saemangeum's growth into a global free trade center, where there is active cooperation among economic communities.

**◆ Hub City of Agricultural Biotechnology**

Jeollabuk-do has been focusing on the agricultural biotechnology industry as a solution for Korea's future food crisis. It is developing into the Silicon Valley of the agricultural biotechnology industry based on a National Food Cluster, a Private Breeding Research Complex, specialized clusters in different regions, and agricultural industrial complexes.

**◆ The Carbon Fiber Industry**

The high-performance carbon fiber that Jeollabuk-do became the world's third and Korea's first to develop is a high value-added material whose economic value reaches KRW 100 trillion. Jeollabuk-do plans to open the door to a new world in the carbon industry by making a connection between the carbon industry and growth engines.

**◆ 2017 World Taekwondo Championships**

Located in Muju, Taekwondowon is the world's only Taekwondo-specialized space that covers all aspects of Taekwondo. It consists of the Taekwondo Museum, a theater, an arena, an experience center, and a training center. It will serve as the venue of the 2017 World Taekwondo Championships, 2,000 athletes from around 160 countries across the globe will participate.

**◆ Jeonju Hanok Village**

The Jeonju Hanok Village embodies the most unique Korean sentiments and values. It was chosen as the 'Star of Korean Tourism' and the 'Best Attraction of Korean Tourism' that tourists within Korea and abroad must visit. It was designated as an International Slow City in 2012, receiving recognition for retaining traditional beauty.
