

URBAN GOVERNANCE SURVEY

The United Nations are currently debating what the future priorities for the world development agenda for post-2015 will be. As the world becomes increasingly urbanised (with over 60% of the global population living in urban areas in the near future) urban governance is one of the central issues in these discussions.

In order to contribute to this process and in preparation for Habitat III, LSE Cities, UN Habitat and UCLG have developed this survey which will allow us to map different governance arrangements in diverse cities around the world in an attempt to better understand how contemporary cities are organised and managed, and how they prepare and plan for the future.

Initial results will be included in the LSE Cities research for this year's 2014 Urban Age conference in Delhi, India which will bring together a wide range of policy makers, academics and city experts to discuss the role of urban governance in shaping the future development of cities. In addition, the survey results will inform the 4th Global Report on Decentralisation and Local Democracy (GOLD IV), a publication that examines the situation of local governments around the world.

The completion of this study requires the participation of local governments in different countries to incorporate diverse realities and learn from their experiences. It also seeks to identify risk factors and analytical tools used in city management.
