Abstract: From Metropolis and Un-Habitat's call to action for World Metropolitan Day 2021, Politecnico di Milano_Polo Territoriale Piacenza, ESR Forum and Heritopolis Network propose the dialogue "METropolitan HERitage Caring Metropolises - ESR Forum for World Metropolitan Day". The seminar to be held on 5th of October 2021, focuses on the international and multidisciplinary contextualization of information related to new Metropolitan Heritage's spaces for caring Metropolises. Reading city's heritage spaces could reveal spatial values of Caring that are essential to bring about change and ensure prosperity and sustainability for all inhabitants of the Metropolis that is now called upon to respond to the urgent needs of long-term planning and design perspectives for all, to mitigate the impacts of the COVID-19 crisis.
